

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR EXISTING DOORS

Measure Twice. Order Once.

Measuring your existing kitchen or bedroom doors is **easier than you think**.

Most customers complete their measurements in around **30 minutes**.

Simply follow the steps below and record your measurements on the enclosed Measuring Worksheet.

BEFORE YOU START

You'll need:



A tape measure
(showing millimetres)



A pen or pencil

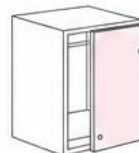
Your existing doors

THE 3 GOLDEN RULES

1

Measure the Door – Not the Cabinet

Replacement doors are manufactured to the size of your existing doors, not the cabinet behind them.



2

Measure the Back of the Door

The back of the door provides the flattest surface and the most accurate measurement.

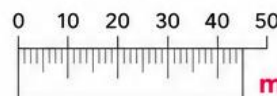

Always Measure in Millimetres (mm)

Every millimetre matters.

Never use centimetres or inches.

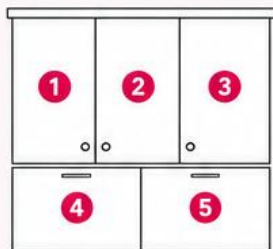


HOW TO MEASURE

STEP 1

Number Your Doors

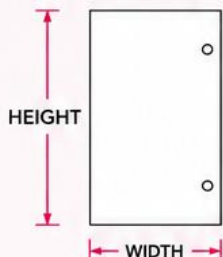
Give every door and drawer a number and record it on your Measuring Worksheet.



STEP 2

Measure the Height & Width

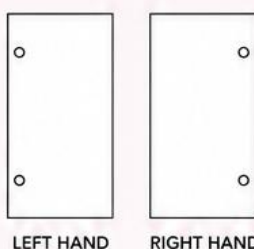
Measure the height and width of every door individually. Even doors that look identical can vary slightly.



STEP 3

Record the Hinge Side

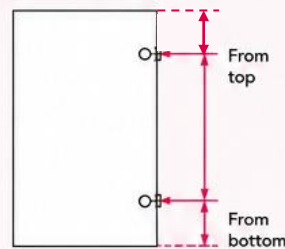
Record whether the hinges are on the left or right when looking at the front of the door.



STEP 4

Measure Hinge Positions (If Required)

If you're ordering hinge holes, measure from the top or bottom edge of the door to the centre of each hinge hole.
